MINUTES OF THE L.C.R.C.C MEETING OF OCTOBER 6, 2005

**TREASURERS REPORT FOR
OCTOBER 2005**

Meeting called to order at 7:16 pm.

Steve Yeaton gave the treasurer's report. The beginning balance was \$4076.04 and ending balance is \$3837.35.
Bill Braun gave the field officer's report. The grass is green and growing and was rolled twice. We have grass seed to oversee the area around the pits this fall.
It was discussed whether or not to fill in the swale with top soil. The cost couldn't be justified at this time.
Dick Hultz wasn't available for the safety officer's report. A man was injured when he lost his balance while holding onto a motorized with the propeller spinning. He received a serious cut to his forehead.
There was also a bad accident at the Racine club involving a helicopter at the Racine field. A man was hit in the face with the rotor. NO one was permanently injured, but please be careful.
