Dave Harrington who has been running the raffle at the club meetings and the annual picnics said that the raffle is losing money. Dave says the cash on hand including prizes is down to \$355.04. He keeps the losses to a minimum because of direct cash donations to the raffle and some club members donating items to be raffled off. He asked for \$250 from the club treasury so that he could go to Venture and purchase items to be raffled for several months at a time rather than driving down monthly. This way he could also get better deals from Venture. The \$250 was seconded and passed on a showing of hands. This brings the total of cash to a little over \$600 on hand for Dave to make his purchases. Several members acknowledged the great effort shown by Dave to keep the raffle going.

Thanks to 3 members we had a very informative night. Jeff displayed a 4 cylinder 4 stroke 320 size OS Engine he intends on installing in a Giant Telemaster. Ron showed 2 electric foam planes he designed and built with coreless servos. The monoplane weighs in at 7 or 8 oz. The other one is a biplane that can be flown out doors and weighs in at about 10oz. Ron says it takes about 3 days to build one of his models. Rob showed his Cap 21 which everyone calls a snap. It's a Model Tech unit and it has pull - pull elevators and rudder.
