### MINUTES of the L.C.R.C.C. MEETING May 3, 2007

#### Field Officer Report

Dick Hultz volunteered to cut the grass on Friday May 4<sup>th</sup> so the grass will be looking good for the "First Flight Fright Day" event coming up on Sunday May 6<sup>th</sup>.

#### Safety Officer Report

Steve Yeaton made a new label for the 2.4 GHz area of the frequency board and Keith Bradley installed all new clips for the permits. Dick also wants to remind everyone to post their permit on the board even if you use the newer spread spectrum radios or the older 72 MHz radios.

#### Treasurer's Report

Steve Yeaton gave the treasurer's report which will be posted in the Fly Paper.

#### Events Director
