### Field Officer's Report

Bill Lewis says the field is in good shape, and wishes to thank those people who volunteered to help with miscellaneous jobs. The oil in the tractor has been changed, and a new battery was installed. There seems to be a problem with the alternator, which Bill will be working on.

### Safety Officer's Report

Keith Storrs was not at the meeting, so there was no Safety Officer's report.

### Treasurer's Report

Steve Yeaton gave the treasurer's report which is posted in the Fly Paper.

### Events Director

Glenn Learnahan reminded us of the upcoming Giant Scale Day, July 8<sup>th</sup>. John Russell reminded us there might be some members of the Sky Knights Club in attendance.

### Old Business

Cub Day was cancelled due to bad weather. In the past, the feature would have been moved to the following week. Because the volunteer cook might not be available for whatever reason, and there being no way to get another cook on such notice, it was decided after some deliberation and discussion, that a cancelled event would be merged with a future event.

The monthly raffle was cancelled at the last meeting, and Sal Grisaffi mentioned a 50/50 raffle might have some interest. With the approval of the members he took over the raffle. Half of the money collected would go to the winner, and the other half would go to the club treasury. Sal has offered to run the raffle at the monthly events as well as at the meetings.

This person must also have a valid Forest Preserve permit card which MUST be displayed on the frequency board. Car keys, AMA card, or other form of ID are not acceptable.

Rule #10 There shall be no flying of any sort beyond the flying zone, over pit area, flight area, parking or other designated restricted areas. This includes any maneuver, take-off or landing approach. No flying over entrance road except when required for proper landing.

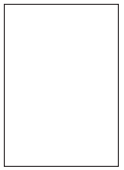
