### Minutes for LCRCC Meeting May 1, 2008

The meeting was called to order by Dick Hultz in the basement of Corky's at approximately 7:15 pm.

#### Field Officer's Report

Bill Lewis says the field has been rolled twice, and cut twice and is in pretty good shape. The benches and tables have been put back in place. The Forest Preserve has dug out and formed the space for the ramp into the shed, as well as a stoop for the service door. Bill has asked that smokers please pick up their cig butts/filters. Otherwise he has to pick them up in order to keep the area looking nice.

He asked for volunteers for weed whackers, since he has no extra space in his vehicle. Two people volunteered, Jim Spice and Russ Scott. There was also a motion to buy one in case the other two don't work.

He also mentioned the windsock requires a fair amount of wind to move it, and suggested possibly getting a wind vane. Keith Storrs said he has the one we had at the ninth street field and would get together with someone to have it installed on the end of the frequency board, opposite the wind sock. This seems to be a good place, since you would be looking at the windsock anyway.

#### Safety Officer's Report

Keith Storrs mentioned a couple of small violations, but everyone was willing to cooperate, and live up to the field rules. There were also a number of non-members one day, and didn't know how to get info for joining the club. Steve Yeaton suggested referring them to the club web-site if there is nothing else available (See Old Business regarding sign).

#### Treasurer's Report

Steve Yeaton gave the treasurer's report which is posted in the Fly Paper.

#### Events Director

Glenn Learnahan returned from his Sabbatical (?) and confirmed the proposed events schedule (See page 4). He also was curious as to whether members from other clubs could fly at our field. The Forest Preserve says YES, but you MUST have the Lake County permit.

#### Old Business

Dick Hultz reviewed the Schedule of Events, and there was also some discussion of possible helicopter events. Those concerned should contact Glenn and work something out. Porta-Potty. Gary Allen presented his findings. Dick Hultz had also done some research. Potties could be purchased from \$100 to \$300.00 depending on condition. Briefly, renting a potty would cost \$590.00 for 7 months, plus pick up and delivery for \$40.00 each. Either way, the cost to the club would be about \$600.00 per year. If you wish further details contact Dick Hultz, who has the details.

After much discussion, pro and con, it was decided to rent a Porta Potty for the first year. We can gain some experience from this method. The cost would be as shown above.

Whether we rent or buy, a crew will be needed to prepare a level place for the potty. Volunteers should contact any of the officers and they, the volunteers, would be expected to coordinate their own activities.

Dave Harrington is still looking for someone to replace him as raffle chairman.

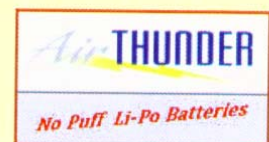

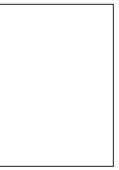
