Minutes for LCRCC Meeting, April 2, 2009

Meeting Minutes

Field Officer's Report

Bill Lewis reported that price of Soda has gone up and he would look for sales for our activities. The Tractor exhaust manifold was leaking and that was being attended to. Also, the alternator which was rebuilt once before does not seem to be charging. He said he will look into that and get it repaired as needed. Bill stated he has begun mowing with the hand mowers doing some trimming and everything is ready to go as soon as weather permits with rolling and mowing.

No Problems have been reported.

Events Director

Johnnie Russell reported, in absence of Tony Lawless (In Toledo with Dick Hultz), that Jim & Joan Doubek will cook for our Annual Picnic again as in the past.

Old Business

Steve reported about some cards that Bill and he carry to promote our field/club. These cards have already been distributed to some local hobby shops etc.

New Business

Steve reported about a meeting that Dick and he had with the Lake County Forest Preserve. In this meeting discussion was about the changes to allow electric flying from sunrise to sunset along with soaring/sailplanes or anything without noise producing elements. A written proposal was presented to them by Steve and the response was such that it appears there will be no problem passing that item through the LCFP Board. Also, the "wish list" was discussed including expansion of the parking lot, paving the spectator area, a new shelter for the spectator area, re-grading the drive, and some small maintenance items.

The outcome of these inquiries was that it looks like the expansion of the parking lot may be doable, the re-grading has been done, and the other large items, because of budget limitations, will probably not be addressed this year. The Forest Preserve Management is still very pleased with our operation at the field and has had no complaints. Also, the Rangers have given positive reports on our field operations. (*Late breaking news! – New hours of operation were approved. - Ed.*)

Discussion was had about the ID Cards issued with Permits from the Forest Preserve. These cards are now mailed after you get your permit. The Forest Preserve is printing their own and will send them through the mail if you opt to use online subscription.

Steve also reported that our Charter renewal has been completed. The AMA has announced a competition for new membership applications. Clubs can win prizes for new memberships. A brochure is available for further information along with a video with details. Contact Steve if you are interested in chairing this program for our club.

Indoor flying is completed as of the April 3. (*Secretary Report: There will be continued flying next year at the same facility.*)

Bill Lewis reported that servicing of the porta-potty has resumed. (Much to the *Relief* of the flyers)

A short discussion was also had about using multiple servos/receivers etc., and the electronics necessary to safely power radio systems in larger aircraft.

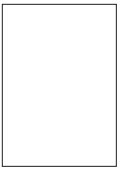
