Safety Officer's Report

Johnnie Russell stated that no incidents have been reported to him. The new rules have been put into effect about no Taxiing into the pits, as discussed at the last meeting.

Events Director

Tony Lawless was not in attendance. Dick commented that the "Giant Scale/Warbirds" day went very well with a large turnout and all was good for this month's Biplane day, coming up.

Old Business

Dick Hultz brought up the issue of the new pit rules, as previously discussed under safety Officers report.
