John Russell Brought an indoor foamy he constructed from "Beast" components. Weighing in at 1.25 oz, he explained how he made it and the materials he used.


There was one new member ... Jason Van Passenn. Welcome aboard!!

Reply from Dick Durbin

Thank you for your message regarding Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations on model aircrafts. I appreciate hearing from you on this issue.

Model airplanes have been a source of educational recreation for many years.

Constructing and flying motorized aircraft can help stir scientific curiosity in our youth.

As the flying capabilities of model airplanes become more sophisticated, many have argued that the FAA should regulate their use within the National Airspace System. Enthusiasts, on the other hand, contend that model airplanes pose a minimal risk when their operators adhere to basic safety guidelines and that FAA focus should on regulating larger, unmanned aircraft.

The Senate recently passed its FAA reauthorization legislation, which included an amendment that would allow model airplane activity to take place in accordance with community-based safety guidelines. The FAA bill proposed by the House does not include this measure. However, I will keep your thoughts in mind when the House and Senate work together to reconcile their respective bills.
