Meeting minutes April 5, 2012

Secretary report:

Field officer report:

Also, we have a new "Zero turn" mower that was donated to the club by Bob Grazier (Thanks Bob) and it is in the shed, with our other tractor. Because of the two mowers in the shed our roller is now outside next to the Porta Potty, which has also been placed on service.

Johnnie Russell reported that he has been out of town but has had no reported incidents...

Events Director:

Bill Rago informed the group that everything is set up for the season opener (April 22) There will be Coffee and Doughnuts available.

He asked the club for a few more "Cook" volunteers, and after some discussion among the members present, all but our June 10th event, are covered. If you would like to volunteer to cook contact Bill. Remember; "NO cook for an event...means, NO food!!

Bill also said that he had contacted Jim Dubek and had confirmed that our picnic date of Aug. 5th will work.

Old Business:

The demonstration at Great Lakes Naval Training base is scheduled for July 3rd. Those in the Club that want to participate in the event have to be registered with the base. So, if you want to be included, your information will need to be given to Dick or Johnnie Russell. Background checks, etc. are required by the Navy for anyone gaining access to the base.
